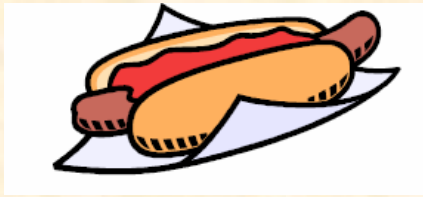

Dance(tonians) was formed in 1971 and celebrated 37 years of dancing at the July Annual Meeting and Dance with highlights of another successful year. The evening began with an excellent Samba lesson taught by popular dance professional John Bucholz and an evening of dancing followed to the great music of maestros Bonnie and Jack Yaus.

At intermission Chairperson Linda Shapiro highlighted the year that included a successful Dance Fair held in May at Hara Arena with over 220 in attendance that featured a delicious dinner, general dancing, and over 50 fantastic exhibitions performed by professional and amateur dancers from throughout Ohio and the region. Supporting Dance Fair provides revenue throughout the year that subsidizes the monthly dances. In addition to Dance Fair, Dance(tonians) sponsor eleven dances throughout the year on the second Saturday of each month that includes a free dance lesson at the beginning of the dance taught by area-wide professionals. Because of the positive comments and good attendance, the board voted to continue this format for the 08-09 year.

These instructors have ventured into the inner city to teach its youth ballroom dancing. In addition to dance instruction, these dance teachers have also organized competitions between schools. Children, the same as adults, need decent shoes to make them feel more in touch with the dance floor. As you might guess, coming up with the money for shoes may be all but out of reach for these kids.

That's where dancers reading this need to reach into their closets to find dance shoes that could possibly be donated to those young dancers. Swing 'n' Sway has undertaken to collect shoes donated to these youth programs. The club will provide boxes in which to collect used but serviceable shoes for boys and girls. If you don't have useable shoes, then make a donation so the shoes collected can be upgraded with new soles and heels. All dancers, regardless of club affiliation or lack thereof, are invited to join us in the effort. These children are the future of this activity. If it is to remain healthy, it will need active younger members. Watch for the donation boxes to appear at Arbor Hall. IN the meantime, see what you can come up with after scrounging around in the closet.
