This is a little bit different. I have been reading a book entitled "The B Side: The Death of Tin Pan Alley and the Rebirth of the Great American Song" by Ben Yagoda. Mr Yagoda chronicles the conflict between the American Society of Composers, Artists, and Publishers (ASCAP) and the Broadcast Music, Incorporated, the power of the artist and repertoire men (A&R) and the disk jockeys (DJs), and other stories about the sources of our fine Great American Songs.

The A&R men (the most notable was Mitch Miller at Columbia Records) could make or break an artist because they were the people who assigned the songs to artists under contract. Frank Sinatra was very unhappy with the novelty song assignments he got from Mitch Miller. He wanted to perform songs from the great composers of the time. He couldn't get out of his Columbia contract fast enough.

DJs were employed by the radio stations to select and play records on the air. The term "disk jockey" was coined by Variety magazine in 1941. Early fears were that DJs would hurt record sales because you didn't have to buy a top 40 tune when it was being played regularly on the radio. The result was quite the opposite and record sales took off.

The recording studios had what were known as plugmen who would take records directly to the radio station DJs. One of the funny stories in the book was about a Jazz DJ in Salt Lake City who was given a record in 1949. He played it during his Jazz show. As the song played he became incensed as it wasn't a jazz tune. To express his displeasure, he played the song over and over for the next 3+ hours giving it a different title each time it played. The song became a hit in Salt Lake City and eventually across America - "I'm Looking Over A Four Leaf Clover", written in 1927.

Be sure to tell our DJ's what dance tunes you like - I bet they have it.
